

DESIGN-A-BILL

- 1. Decide how much your bill will be worth.** Your bill can be worth any amount that you'd like: 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50, 100. Write this amount in each corner circle; that's four times on the front and four times on the back.
- 2. Decide who will be pictured on the front of your bill.** Your bill can feature a hero, friend, relative, or other person who has made a difference in your life. Draw a picture of that person in the middle circle on the front of the bill. Write their name in the box below their picture.
- 3. Decide which building or important place makes you think of the person on the front.** Draw a picture that relates to your hero in the large oval on the back of the bill. Write the name of the place or event in the box below your picture.
