YNCU SUPPORTS HUNGER RELIEF AT ROTARYFEST IN SAULT STE. MARIE, WITH A WAGON FULL OF HELP

Supporting Harvest Algoma with food donations and spreading joy through the Miracle Mile Colour Blast

SAULT STE. MARIE, ON | July 14, 2025 - Your Neighbourhood Credit Union (YNCU) is excited to join the 102nd Annual ROTARYFEST Community Day Parade on Saturday, July 19, at 11:00 a.m., with a dual purpose: bringing community spirit to Bay Street and helping to fight hunger in the process.

As part of ROTARYFEST, YNCU will be collecting non-perishable food items along the parade route to benefit Harvest Algoma, a vital local food hub supporting individuals and families facing food insecurity. Parade-goers are encouraged to bring donations, including canned goods, pasta, rice, and hygiene products such as toothbrushes, to help stock shelves at a time of year when donations often run low.

"We're incredibly grateful to YNCU and the ROTARYFEST community for stepping up to support our work," says David Thompson, Director of Harvest Algoma. "Summer is a tough time for food banks; shelves tend to run low, but the need doesn't go away. Every can, every box of pasta, every donation collected along the parade route helps us feed more families. It's a powerful reminder of what we can do when we come together."

Ahead of the parade, YNCU is also proud to sponsor the Miracle Mile Colour Blast, happening at 10:30 a.m. This family-friendly walk, run, or roll begins at Canadian Bushplane Heritage Centre and ends at the GFL Memorial Gardens, with three fun-filled colour stations along the way and a 'final blast' of colour to cap it all off.

"Events like ROTARYFEST bring people together and remind us of who we are as a community, joyful, generous, and connected," says Lisa Colangelo, CEO of YNCU. "At YNCU, we're committed to supporting the well-being of the communities we serve, and that includes tackling food insecurity head-on.
